## By-the-Bay 3K Participants Welcome to Race Weekend!

### RACE BIB PICK-UP and the HEALTH & FITNESS EXPO

You can pick-up your By-the-Bay 3K bib at one of two times and locations:

- The Health & Fitness Expo is Friday, April 26, from noon to 6 PM at the Monterey Conference Center at 1 Portola Plaza in downtown Monterey.
- Race morning, Saturday, April 27 at Lovers Point Park in Pacific Grove beginning at 6:30 AM.

### **Driving directions to the Expo:**

- From southbound Highway 1, take the Monterey exit 401A, turn right on Camino Aguajito, then left on Del Monte Avenue.
- From northbound Highway 1, exit at Munras Avenue (exit 399B). Munras becomes Abrego Street and then Washington Street. Head straight on Washington, then left on Del Monte.

Bibs can picked up in the Steinbeck Ballroom located on the third floor of the Monterey Conference Center. Bibs and shirts must be picked up in person unless a <u>Packet Pick-Up Authorization form</u> has been filled out. Please bring your photo ID. You can look up your bib number at the Expo.

**Note:** Because we try to minimize our event's environmental impact as part of our "green" initiative, we do not hand out bags filled with paper promotional materials or product samples. You will be sent a link to a virtual goodie bag a week or so before the race which will include valuable electronic coupons.

### **RACE DAY: SATURDAY, APRIL 27**

The 3K race begins at 8 a.m. at Lovers Point Park in Pacific Grove. More than 4,500 runners are expected including students, teachers, and families from more than 40 schools.

### **Parking**

There is street and lot parking near Lovers Point and in downtown Pacific Grove. Please note meters and lot rates and enforcement times.

# **RACE INFO**

### Race Day Packet Pick-up

Packet pick-up is available in the upper parking lot of Lovers Point Park from 6:30 until 8 AM. Late registration is also available if you know of others who wish to do this event. Shirt sizes are first-come, first-served on race day. If you already have your bib, you do not need to check in race morning at Lovers Point.

Please wear your race bib on the **FRONT** of your shirt or shorts. It should always be visible during the race.,

### The Start and Course

The 3K (1.8-mile) race features six separate waves starting six minutes apart. Open runners, those who did not register through a school, should have blue race numbers and will will begin in the final wave at 8:30 a.m. Listen carefully for announcements on when to line up for your wave.

The By-the-Bay 3K is a non-timed fun run. There is no race clock, timing, or awards. The course is an out-and-back on Ocean View Blvd. in Pacific Grove. It is flat and scenic featuring stunning views of Monterey Bay. There is one water station at the turn-around about 0.9 miles from the start.

Note that because you will begin in the final wave, if you are a faster runner or walker, you will be passing participants from earlier waves. This is a fun run for a personal challenge, but it is not a timed race and there are no performance awards so please be careful out there!

There are medical personnel on site and on bicycles during the race.

### The Finish and After the Race

The 3K finishes near the start on Ocean View Boulevard. After you cross the finish line, you will receive a finish medal and light refreshments. There is entertainment at Lovers Point Park and a brief ceremony to honor the schools with participation awards. There are no results or age-group awards in the 3K and the event is generally over by 10 a.m.

### INFORMATION BOOTH AND LOST AND FOUND

If you have any questions at the race, please visit our information booth located in Lovers Point Park. This is where we also monitor lost and found items and also help connect families and children.

After the race, we encourage you to visit nearby downtown Pacific Grove and its eclectic mix of coffee shops,

restaurants, shopping and galleries. You may also wish to return to the Monterey Conference Center in downtown Monterey to enjoy the second day of the Big Sur Marathon Expo. Activities continuing at the Expo include:
